Dear parents and carers

Following the PM's announcement last week, we will be continuing to follow our risk assessment and "hands, face and space" guidance and will be remaining in our bubbles.

The trip planned to the Yorkshire Wildlife Park on **2nd July 2021**, will be going ahead as planned. Please note we will be leaving the academy at 9am and will return at approximately 4pm. Those children who travel home on the bus will be allowed to remain on the bus after all others have disembarked at school, to then be taken home on the regular school run. If you haven't made payment for the trip yet, please can you do so before 2nd July.

We will be holding our Sports week again this year – further details to follow. We will remain in our bubbles when taking part in the different events. As part of sports week, we will be holding a Sports day competition, but unfortunately, we will not be inviting parents and carers due to the need for social distancing. We politely request that you do not attempt to attend as we would have to call a halt to the competition if an audience gathered.

On 13th July we will hold a parent meeting for children transitioning from Foundation Stage into Year 1. This meeting will be held via Zoom and a zoom link will be sent nearer the time.

We will be able to hold our annual year 6 sleepover in the hall. This will take place on **Friday 16th July**. Children will leave school as normal at 3.20pm and return to school at 6pm. Weather permitting, we will hold a game of rounders on the field. Due to Covid restrictions and government guidance, we are asking that parents do not attend this.

The children will need to bring: a sleeping bag/quilt, a pillow, appropriate full-length pyjamas, a washbag including a toothbrush, toothpaste etc and they can also bring a few sweets to eat during the film if they wish. The children will have adequate sleeping arrangements so there is no need for them to bring an air or camping bed.

We will ensure there are plenty of fun and games; followed by a film and snacks with hot chocolate before sleep. We will provide breakfast also. Children should be collected at 8am. We are asking that children do not bring any technology with them to the sleepover, this includes mobile phones.

On **19th July** we are still planning a teddy bears picnic for the Foundation children. Please ensure they come to school with their teddy on that day!

On **21st July**, if restrictions are lifted, we will be holding our playground party for the afternoon, where all children will be able to eat and play together on the playground. We will also be inviting our new starters for September to join us.

This year's leavers performance will be a virtual performance. Although it may be disappointing to parents to not attend their child's final performance in school, we will be videoing and giving you access so you will have a record to treasure always. The performance will take place in the last week and we will send you details of how to access it.

Children will receive their leaving gifts within the academy, kindly donated by Worlaby Parish council; Bonby parish council; Barton Rotary Club and the Friends of Worlaby School.

Please continue to be aware of potential symptoms of Covid and keep your child at home if they have symptoms. As soon as possible please organise a test.
