

Reading

This term we will be enjoying a variety of texts in our strategy lessons, guided reading sessions and whole class reading time.

In our reading strategy lessons we are reading 'Stig of the Dump' by Clive King. We will discuss and write about these books, answering mixed domain questions. We will also be reading poetry and non-fiction text that link to our book.

Maths

We are now in the summer term which means we will be revising many of the maths units including number and place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, fractions and statistics.

In addition, we will be learning about angles and the properties of 2-D and 3-D shapes in a geometry unit.

We are very enthusiastic about times tables in Rowling Class. We will continue practicing these every day with songs, games and challenges!

Writing

As writers, we are following our Talk for Writing sequence, learning about stories about characters with flaws e.g. greedy and sleepy. We are also learning how to create action in our writing, using devices such as personification and powerful verbs.

We are excited to be holding an exciting writing festival and competition in June!

Art & DT

In our art lessons we will be looking at Stone Age cave paintings. We will experiment using berries, soil and petals to add colour and explore the use of gradient and tone using sketching pencils. In DT we will be making stable structures and hidden joints when we recreate an Iron Age house.

Music

As musicians, we will be experimenting with tempo variation as we sing and play the glockenspiel to our new R & B song called 'Let your Spirit Fly'.

RE

In RE lessons, we will find out the meaning of 'pilgrimage' and looking at what this means in different religions.

PSHE

In PSHE, we are learning about careers and economic Wellbeing. In addition, we will be looking at healthy lifestyles including sex education.
